

SEC. 2. There is also hereby appropriated to said institute the further sum of six thousand dollars, for the support of the same during the present year, including the maintenance of the pupils therein, the payment of the salaries of the principal, the professors and assistants, and the other necessary current expenses thereof. How disbursed

SEC. 3. The said sums of money shall be expended for the above purposes under the direction of the trustees, who shall report to the Governor, at the close of the present year, a full and particular statement and account of the expenditure thereof, and they shall be paid out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

An Act to change the name of George Fatterlee to George William Meeker.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The name of George Satterlee, infant son of George Satterlee, Sen'r, of Iowa county, is hereby changed to George William Meeker, by which last mentioned name he shall hereafter be known in all places whatsoever.

Chapter 27.

An Act to change the time of holding the circuit court in the counties of La Crosse, Bad Ax and Crawford.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The circuit court in and for the county of La Crosse, shall be holden on the second Monday of May, Time of holding court changed in La Crosse county.

and on the second Monday of November, in each year, and all writs, process, notices, conveyances, or proceedings whatever, pending in said court, or that may hereafter be pending therein, shall be deemed and made returnable to said terms as so above stated, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

Time changed
in Crawford co.

SEC. 2. The circuit court in and for the county of Crawford, shall be holden on the fourth Monday of May, and on the fourth Monday of November in each year, and all writs, process, notices, recognizances, or proceedings whatever pending in said court, or that may hereafter be pending therein, shall be deemed and made returnable to said terms above stated, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

Time changed
in Bad Ax co.

SEC. 3. The circuit court in and for the county of Bad Ax shall be holden on the second Monday of June, and the second Monday of December in each year, and all writs, process, notices, recognizances, or proceedings whatever, pending in said court, or that may hereafter be pending therein, shall be deemed and made returnable to said terms above stated, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

Chapter 28.

An Act to provide for the division of the County of Adams, and to submit the question to a vote of the people.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Electors to
vote upon divi-
sion of county.

SECTION 1. At the general election in November next, the legal voters of the county of Adams may vote upon the question of a division of said county; and in case a majority of the votes cast at such election shall be in favor of division, then, and in that case, all that portion of said county lying west of the main channel of the Wis-
