AN ACT to amend Chapter 115 of Session Laws of 1856, entitled "An Act to provide for the annual examination of the accounts of certain State Officers.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

§ 1. That Section one of Chapter one hundred and fifteen is hereby amended, by inserting after the words "University Lands," the words "Bank Comptroller and Superintendent of Public Instruction." Chap. 115, Laws of 1856 amended.

§ 2. This act shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage.

Published, March 30, 1857.

AN ACT to provide for the auditing and payment of the Postage of the Members and Officers of the Senate and Assembly.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

§ 1. The Secretary of State is hereby authorized and required to audit the accounts for postage or printed matter sent and received by members and officers of the present Legislature, and when so audited shall certify the same to the State Treasurer, who is hereby authorized to pay the same. Postage of Members of the Legislature.

§ 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
