

Lake, and shall belong and appertain to the office of the Register of Deeds for the said county of Green Lake, and shall have the like effect, for all purposes, as if originally entered in the office of the Register of Deeds for said county.

To transcribe records.

SEC. 2. The county board of supervisors of the county of Marquette are hereby authorized, at any time they may deem it necessary, to employ some person to transcribe such portion of the records mentioned in the first section of this act, as may relate to the title of all the lands then lying and being situate within the limits of the said county of Marquette; and the person thus employed to transcribe said records, shall have access to the office of the Register of Deeds for the county of Green Lake for that purpose, copies of the records thus obtained and entered in the office of the Register of Deeds for the county of Marquette shall be of like form and effect as if originally entered of record in said county.

County of Green Lake liable to one-half the expense.

Proviso.

SEC. 3. The county of Green Lake shall be liable to pay to the county of Marquette one-half of the expense in transcribing the records, as provided in section two of this act; *Provided*, that the whole amount for which the county of Green Lake shall be held liable to pay the county of Marquette shall not exceed two and one-half cents per folio of the records transcribed.

Repealed.

SEC. 4. So much of the provisions of the act of which this is amendatory as conflicts with the provisions of this act is hereby repealed.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

AN ACT to authorize the Speaker to certify to the per diem and mileage of Duncan E. Cameron.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Speaker to certify to mileage and per

SECTION 1. It shall be lawful for the Speaker of the Assembly, and he is hereby authorized and required to

certify to the per diem and mileage of Hon. Duncan E. Cameron, a member of the Assembly from the fourth ward of the city of Milwaukee, the same as if he had been able to be in his seat from the commencement of the session.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

AN ACT to fix the Compensation of the Revisors of the General Laws of the State.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to F. S. Lovell, S. J. Todd and David Taylor, the sum of thirteen hundred and fifty dollars each out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, in full for services as Revisors of the general laws of this State.

Appropriated to the Revisors

SEC. 2. The several sums of money audited by the Secretary of State, and paid out of the State treasury to said Revisors under the provisions of chapter 98 of the general laws of 1857, shall be considered a part of the appropriation made by this act, and shall be deducted therefrom, and the balance, after making such deduction, shall be paid by the State Treasurer under the provisions of this act.

To be considered part of this appropriation.

SEC. 3. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
