CHAPTER 125.

AN ACT to authorize the publication of the banking law in pamphlet form.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The bank comptroller is hereby authorized to have printed under the contract of the state printer, in pamphlet form, five thousand copies of the banking law, as amended by the act entitled "an act to amend chapter four hundred and seventy-nine of the general laws of Wisconsin, for the year 1852, entitled 'an act to authorize the business of banking in the state of Wisconsin,' approved May 15th, 1858," and other laws now in force in this state relating to banking, with an appendix of forms for the organization of banks, and the same, when printed, shall be placed in the bank comptroller's office for distribution.

SEC. 2. The expenses attending the printing and compilation of said laws, shall be certified by the bank comptroller to the secretary of state, who shall audit and draw his warrant on the state treasurer for the payment of the same.

CHAPTER 126.

AN ACT to provide for the removal of the county seat of La Pointe county.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. At the next general annual election the legal voters of the county of La Pointe in this state, shall be, and are hereby authorized to vote for the removal of the county seat of said county, from La Pointe, on the island, to Bayfield, in said county of La Pointe, which point is hereby fixed as the point to which is proposed to remove said county seat, and if a majority of all the votes on that subject at such election be in favor of such
