CHAPTER 41.

AN ACT restoring George Bryant to citizenship.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

Restored to citizenship.

SECTION 1. George Bryant, a late convict in the state prison of this state, is hereby restored to citizenship and shall enjoy the same rights and privileges to all intents and purposes which he had and was entitled to before his conviction.

Take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 42.

AN ACT to amend section one hundred and twenty-nine, of chapter thirteen of the revised statutes, entitled, "Of counties and county officers."

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

Amended.

SECTION 1. Section one hundred and twenty-nine of chapter thirteen of the revised statutes, entitled "Of counties and county officers," is hereby amended by adding at the end of said section the following: *Provided*, no city or town treasurer shall be allowed to pay a larger amount in county orders than he has received in the collection of county taxes, said amount to be determined by the affidavit of such treasurer.

Proviso.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
