

CHAPTER 120.

[Published April 5, 1860.]

AN ACT to change the boundaries of the counties of Marathon, Shawanaw and Oconto.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. All that part of range ten east, north of the south boundary line of township number twenty-six north, is hereby taken from the counties of Oconto and Shawanaw, and attached to and made a part of the county of Marathon for all purposes whatever: *Provided*, all taxes now levied in said range may be collected in all respects the same as if this act had not passed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 121.

[Published March 23, 1860.]

AN ACT to provide for the disposal of the drainage fund moneys in the county of Fond du Lac.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The drainage commissioner of the county of Fond du Lac is hereby authorized to receive from the treasurer of said county, and to loan out on good and sufficient real estate securities, under such rules, regulations and restrictions, as have been, or may hereafter be, made by the board of supervisors of said county, all moneys that said county has received, or may hereafter receive, on account of the drainage fund income.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts, in so far as they contravene the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
