

CHAPTER 145.

[Published March 28, 1860.]

AN ACT authorizing the Superintendent of Public Property to purchase the Governor's message in foreign languages, and for an appropriation of money for the payment therefor.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The Superintendent of Public Property is hereby authorized and directed to purchase six thousand copies of the Governor's message in the German language, three thousand copies in the Norwegian language, two thousand copies in the Dutch language, and fifteen hundred copies in the Welsh language, at a cost not to exceed ten cents per copy. Authority to purchase Governor's message.

SEC. 2. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, a sum sufficient for the payment of said messages, at a rate not to exceed ten cents for each copy so purchased. Appropriation

SEC. 3. The Secretary of State is hereby authorized and directed to audit the account for said messages at the price agreed upon by the Superintendent of Public Property, and to draw warrants on the Treasurer for the payment of the same. Sec. of State to audit account.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 146.

[Published March 30, 1860.]

AN ACT authorizing the city of Hudson to issue bonds for the liquidation of indebtedness, and for other purposes.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The common council of the city of Hudson are hereby authorized and empowered to issue bonds of said city, to an amount not exceeding six thousand dollars, for the purpose of paying and taking up the orders of said city that are outstanding, and for no other purpose; such bonds shall be made payable in ten years Authority to issue bonds
