

## CHAPTER 190.

[Published April 10, 1860.]

AN ACT to amend an act, entitled "An act to authorize the laying out of a state road, from the town of Howard, Brown county, to the Menomonee river."

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

Amendment.

SECTION 1. The first section of an act, entitled "An act to authorize the laying out of a state road, from the town of Howard, Brown county, to the Menomonee river," is hereby amended, by striking out the name of John G. Emery, and inserting the name of L. H. Hill.

Further amendment.

SEC. 2. The said section is hereby further amended, by striking out the words "north-easterly direction, to the Peshtigo river, at or near Ogden's Mills, and thence to Menomonee," and insert, in lieu thereof, the words, "northerly, so as to cross the Peshtigo river at or near the township line between townships 80 and 81, and thence to Menomonee river."

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
