

any and all suits commenced to recover any damages for such cutting, taking, or carrying away, without cost to the State.

SEC. 6. The compensation and expenses of such clerks shall be audited by the Secretary of State, upon the certificate of the commissioners, and shall be paid out of the State treasury, out of the income of the several funds for which the service has been rendered. The amount to be paid out of each fund shall be determined by the Secretary of State. An amount sufficient is hereby appropriated, out of the State treasury, to pay all such accounts so audited as aforesaid: "Provided, that the whole amount to be audited, during any one year, for services rendered pursuant to the provisions of this act, shall not exceed the sum of three thousand dollars." Sec'y of state to audit accounts under this law, and determine am't payable from each fund. Appropriation Whole expenses not to exceed \$3,000 per annum.

SEC. 7. Section nine, of chapter twenty-nine, of the Revised Statutes, entitled "Of swamp and overflowed lands," is hereby repealed. Sec. 9, chap. 29, R. S. repealed.

## CHAPTER 278.

[Published April 20, 1860.]

AN ACT to amend chapter 88, of the General Laws of 1857, entitled "An act to authorize the establishment of a House of Refuge for juvenile delinquents in the State of Wisconsin."

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section fourteen, chapter eighty-eight, of the General Laws of 1857, entitled "An act to authorize the establishment of a House of Refuge for juvenile delinquents in Wisconsin," is hereby amended by inserting, after the word "clerk," where it occurs in said section, the words "of the circuit court;" and also by striking out the words "each county clerk," where they occur in said section, and insert instead thereof the words "the clerk of the circuit court in each county." SEC. 2. Section fifteen, of the act of which this act is amendatory, is hereby amended by inserting therein, after the word "larceny," the words "or misdemeanor."

## CHAPTER 279.

[Published April 17, 1860.]

AN ACT for the protection of orchards and fruit trees.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

Amendment to sec. 51, chap. 165, R S SECTION 1. Section fifty-one, of chapter one hundred and sixty-five, of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following, to wit: "or by imprisonment in the county jail not more than thirty days, nor less than five days."

Amendment to sec. 52. SEC. 2. Section fifty-two, of said chapter, is amended by adding thereto the following: "or by imprisonment in the county jail, not more than three months, nor less than ten days."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 280.

AN ACT to authorize the board of trustees of the village of Viroqua, Bad Ax county, to levy a tax.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

Tax for corporation purposes. SECTION 1. The board of trustees, in the village of Viroqua, in the county of Bad Ax, are hereby authorized to levy, for corporation purposes, a tax, not to exceed one per cent. on the taxable real and personal property, situate within the corporate limits of said village, as the same
