

CHAPTER 326.

[Published April 28, 1860.]

AN ACT to amend chapter 157, of the Revised Statutes, entitled "of actions against the State."

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Chapter one hundred and fifty-seven, of the Revised Statutes, entitled "of actions against the State," is hereby so amended as to provide, that whenever a final judgment against the State shall be obtained in the Supreme Court, as provided in the chapter hereby amended, it shall be the duty of the clerk of the said court to make and furnish to the Secretary of State, a transcript of such judgment, and the Secretary of State shall, thereupon, audit, in favor of the person so obtaining such judgment, the amount of damages and costs therein awarded, and shall draw his warrant on the treasury therefor.

Secretary of State to audit claim vs. state on judgment of supreme court.

SEC. 2. There is hereby appropriated from the State Treasury out of any money therein, not otherwise appropriated, a sum sufficient to carry into effect the provisions of the first section of this act.

SEC. 3. This act shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 327.

AN ACT to amend chapter 81, of the Revised Statutes, entitled "of the State Historical Society."

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Sections two, three, four, five, six and seven, of chapter eighty-one, of the Revised Statutes, entitled "of the State Historical Society," are hereby repealed.

Repeal.

SEC. 2. The Society shall be deemed a trustee of the State, for the purpose of faithfully expending the money appropriated thereto, by section one of the act to which

Society deemed trustee for the state.
