

CHAPTER 48.

[Published February 25, 1860.]

AN ACT authorizing the Commissioners of School Lands to vacate a certain sale to Ephraim Cole.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Com'ss'rs S. and U. lands authorized to vacate sale to Eph'm Cole. SECTION 1. That the Commissioners of the school, university, and swamp lands be, and they are hereby authorized and instructed to vacate a certain sale of swamp lands, heretofore made to Ephraim Cole, of the town of Chester, in the county of Dodge, described as the north half of the north-east quarter of section thirty-five, town thirteen, north of range fifteen east, and to allow the said Cole to enter the north half of the north-east quarter of section thirty-four, in the town and range aforesaid, and to issue to him a patent therefor.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 49.

[Published February 25, 1860.]

AN ACT amendatory of, and supplemental to, an act entitled "An Act to provide for the re-assessment of certain taxes in the city of Racine, for the years 1856 to 1859, inclusive," approved February 10th, 1860.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Duties of assessors in the city of Racine relative to omissions in assessments of 1856, 1857 and 1858. SECTION 1. In case any property in said city of Racine, liable to taxation, shall have been omitted from the assessment roll of said city, for either of the years 1856, 1857, or 1858, it shall be the duty of the present assessors of said city to assess the same, for the year or years in which the same was so omitted, and to certify such assessment to the city clerk of said city, on or before the 10th day of March, 1860, and such assessment shall be deemed and taken to be a part of the assessment roll of said city for the year in which the same was so omit-

ted. And in making out the several tax lists mentioned in section 4, of an act entitled "An Act to provide for the re-assessment of certain taxes in the city of Racine, for the years 1856 to 1859 inclusive," approved February 10th, 1860, the city clerk shall compute the taxes upon the property, so returned to him, by such assessors, pursuant to this act, the same as though such property had been originally included in the city assessment roll for the year or years in which the same was so omitted.

Duties of city clerk relative to the same.

¶ SEC. 2. The city clerk and comptroller shall correct any errors in the description of any lands attempted to be described, in either of the said assessment rolls for the years 1856, 1857 or 1858, and the city clerk shall insert in the tax lists mentioned in section 4, of the act to which this act is amendatory, the corrected description of all such lands.

City clerk and compt'r to correct errors in ass't rolls.

¶ SEC. 3. This act shall be published immediately, and shall be in force from and after its publication.

CHAPTER 50.

[Published February 17, 1860.]

AN ACT to amend chapter 252, of the Local Laws of 1858, entitled "An Act to amend an act, entitled 'an act to incorporate the city of La Crosse,'" approved March 14, 1856.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section three (3), of said chapter 252, of Amendm't to the Local Laws of 1858, is hereby amended, so as to read as follows: Section 3, of chapter seven, of the act to which this act is amendatory, is amended as follows:—

La Crosse city charter in ref. to collection of city taxes.

"In all cases of non-payment of taxes upon lots or real estate in said city, in the manner now required by law, it shall be the duty of the treasurer of said city, to proceed in accordance with the provisions of existing laws relating to the sale of lands, for delinquent taxes, in the several counties of this State, whether the certificates of previous sales of said lots or real estate are held by the said city or not, to advertise and sell all delinquent lots and lands within the limits of said city, in the same manner as other lands are sold in said county of La Crosse;
