

CHAPTER 190.

[Published April 12, 1861.]

AN ACT to amend Chapter 59 of the General Laws of 1861, entitled "An act in relation to Steam Vessels navigating certain of the waters of this State."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Additional ex-
ceptions.

SECTION 1. That chapter 59 of the general laws of 1861, entitled "An act in relation to steam vessels navigating certain of the waters of this state," be amended by inserting after the words "Mississippi river" whenever they occur in said act, the words "and its tributaries, and Root river, in the city and county of Racine, and Pike creek, in the city and county of Kenosha."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 191.

AN ACT to lay out a State Road from Alma, in the county of Buffalo, to Prescott, in the county of Pierce.

CHAPTER 192.

[Published April 13, 1861.]

AN ACT to fix the Terms of the Circuit Court in Kewaunee county.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Two terms.

SECTION 1. There shall be two terms of the circuit court held in the county of Kewaunee, in the tenth

judicial circuit, in each year, as follows: One term on the first Monday in January, and one term on the fourth Monday in July.

SECTION 2. There shall be no grand or petit jury summoned or empaneled for the July term of the circuit court for said county of Kewaunee, unless ordered by the judge of said tenth judicial circuit, and notice given by said judge to the clerk of the circuit court of said Kewaunee county at least twenty days before the commencement of said July term of court. When so ordered, a grand and petit jury shall be summoned and empaneled as provided by law in other cases. No juries for July term, unless, &c.

SECTION 3. All acts or parts of acts that conflict with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed. Repeal.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first day of October, 1861.

CHAPTER 193.

[Published April 15, 1861.]

AN ACT to legalize certain Highways in the county of Sheboygan.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. All highways heretofore laid out and established in the town of Greenbush, in the county of Sheboygan, wherein the order of the supervisors of said town established such highways less than four rods wide, are hereby legalized so far as relates to the order of the supervisors establishing such highways. Highways in the town of Greenbush legalized.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
