## CHAPTER 196.

[Published April 12, 1861.]

AN ACT to amend Chapter 209 of the General Laws of 1860, entitled "An act providing for Grand and Petit Jurors in this State," and to amend Section 3, 8 and 13, of Chapter 118 Revised Statutes, entitled "Of Grand and Petit Jurors."

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section two of chapter two hundred and nine of the general laws of 1860, entitled "An act providing for grand and petit jurors in this state," and to amend sections three, eight and thirteen, of chapter one hundred and eighteen of revised statutes, entitled "Of grand and petit jurors," is hereby amended by inserting the words "greater or" before the word "less" in line ten. Also, insert said words before the words "less" in line thirteen. Add to the end of said section two the words "nor more than thirty-six."

More than 24  
petit jurors may  
be drawn.
