

CHAPTER 275.

[Published April 20, 1861.]

AN ACT to amend Chapter 151 of Acts of a General Nature of 1858, entitled "An act to authorize the inhabitants upon Government Lands to form themselves into bodies corporate to carry out the provisions of an act of Congress, approved May 23d, 1841."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section four of chapter one hundred and fifty-one of acts of a general nature of 1858, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following words: "The said trustees shall audit all demands against such town site for expenses incurred in the entry thereof, or for services rendered in behalf of said town site upon request of said trustees, and shall report the amount of such demands so allowed by them to the town clerk of the town wherein said town site is situated, and said town clerk shall thereupon levy the amount so reported as a special tax upon the lots in said town site, according to their assessed value, which tax shall be collected with, and as other taxes, and the amount so collected shall be paid by the treasurer to the person in whose favor the amount was allowed by the trustees: *provided*, that in case of any appeal from the allowance by said trustees, they shall not report to such town clerk until such appeal is determined. Any person may appeal to the circuit court in like manner as is provided for appeals from county boards of supervisors, from the action of the trustees upon such demands, and upon the determination of such appeal the trustees shall report to said town clerk the amount allowed by the court; and said town clerk shall levy and the treasurer pay over such amount in the manner above prescribed."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
