

CHAPTER 47.

[Published February 28, 1861.]

AN ACT to amend Section two of Chapter seven of the Revised Statutes, entitled "Of General and Special Elections, of the manner of conducting the same, and of the canvass."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section two of chapter seven of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following words: "Nor shall any person be deemed to have gained a residence in any town or ward in this state, so as to entitle him to vote at any election in such town or ward, by remaining in such town or ward as a pauper, supported by the town or county in which he shall be living at the time of such election; and no person shall be deemed to have lost his residence in any town or ward by remaining in any other town or ward as such pauper."

Defining place of residence.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 48.

AN ACT to extend the time for the collection of school and village Taxes in the village of Sheboygan Falls, in the county of Sheboygan.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The time for the collection of school and village taxes in the village of Sheboygan Falls in the county of Sheboygan, for the year 1860, is hereby extended to the first day of April, 1861.

Time extended to 1st of April.

SECTION 2. The treasurer of said village shall have the same power and authority to collect the taxes contained in said village tax roll, after as before such extension of time for the collection of said taxes: *pro-*
