

## CHAPTER 92.

[Published March 22, 1861.]

AN ACT to provide for laying out a State Road from Fort Howard, in Brown county, to Stephenville, in Outagamie county, and from thence westward thro' [through] Waupacca county to Stevens Point, in Portage county.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

Commissioners.

SECTION 1. Otto Tank, John Stephens and Gerhard Oldenburg, are hereby appointed commissioners to lay out and establish a state road, beginning at Fort Howard, in Brown county, from thence to the village of Stephenville, in Outagamie county, and from thence to the village of Plover, or city of Stevens Point, in Portage county, by the most feasible route.

Report to be made and issued.

SECTION 2. Said commissioners shall, immediately after laying out said road, cause a report of their survey to be made and filed with the clerk of the board of supervisors of the counties through which said road passes, and in all respects comply with the provisions of chapter nineteen of the revised statutes, so far as the same are applicable.

Compensation.

SECTION 3. Such commissioners shall be entitled to only such compensation as the board of supervisors of the counties through which said road shall pass, shall deem proper, and the same shall be paid by the said counties respectively: *provided*, that no compensation shall be allowed for laying out so much of said road as may lie upon any other road which may have been laid out at the time of laying out said state road.

Proviso.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
