CHAPTER 10.

[Published February 7, 1862.]

AN ACT to extend the time for the collection of taxes in the county of Shawanaw.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Extended to
March 3.

SECTION 1. The time for the collection of taxes, except state taxes, in the county of Shawanaw, is hereby extended to the first Monday of March next.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
