

CHAPTER 104.

[Published March 19, 1862.]

AN ACT for the relief of the Eau Claire county agricultural society.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The secretary of state is hereby authorized and directed to issue an order upon the state treasurer, in favor of the Eau Claire county agricultural society, pursuant to section five of chapter fifty-three of the general laws of 1858, in the same manner as though the annual report of said society had been received and filed previous [previously] to the first day of February, 1862: *provided*, said report be on file in the office of the secretary of state at the time of the passage of this act.

When order may be issued in favor of.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 105.

[Published March 20, 1862.]

AN ACT for the relief of the Lake Superior agricultural society of Douglass county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The secretary of state is hereby authorized and directed to issue an order upon the state treasurer, in favor of the Lake Superior agricultural society of Douglass county, pursuant to section five of chapter fifty-three [of the] general laws of 1858, in the same manner as though the annual report of said society had been received on the first day of February, 1862: *provided*, said report be on file in the office of the secretary of state at the time of the passage of this act.

When order may be issued in favor of.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
