

## CHAPTER 125.

[Published March 26, 1862.]

AN ACT to legalize the official acts of J. H. Deuster, as justice of the peace in the county of Milwaukee.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. That all the official acts and duties performed by J. H. Deuster, as justice of the peace in the town of Lake, in the county of Milwaukee, in this state, prior to the passage of this act, so far as the same are consistent with the general laws of this state, are hereby legalized and declared to be as valid, for all purposes, as though the said J. H. Deuster had caused his official bond and oath, or oaths, to be made and filed in conformity with the statutes. Legalized.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 126.

[Published March 27, 1862.]

AN ACT to provide for the loan of the drainage fund in the county of Jackson, in this state.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. That portion of the drainage fund income now due, or which may hereafter become due, to the county of Jackson, in this state, shall be paid over to the county treasurer of said county, at the same time with the money due to said county of Jackson from the school fund income for each year. Money to be paid to county treasurer.

SECTION 2. The county board of supervisors of the said county of Jackson, is hereby authorized and empowered to loan to the said county of Jackson, for the term of five years, all such drainage fund income, now in the hands of the county treasurer of the said county May be loaned to the county.
