AN ACT to legalize the official acts of J. H. Deuster, as justice of the peace in the county of Milwaukee.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senute and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. That all the official acts and duties per-Legalized. formed by J. H. Deuster, as justice of the peace in the town of Lake, in the county of Milwaukee, in this state, prior to the passage of this act, so far as the same are consistent with the general laws of this state, are hereby legalized and declared to be as valid, for all purposes, as though the said J. H. Deuster had caused his official bond and oath, or oaths, to be made and filed in conformity with the statutes.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 126.

AN ACT to provide for the loan of the drainage fund in the county of Jackson, in this state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. That portion of the drainage fund in- Money to be come now due, or which may hereafter become due, to treasurer. the county of Jackson, in this state, shall be paid over to the county treasurer of said county, at the same time with the money due to said county of Jackson from the school fund income for each year.

SECTION 2. The county board of supervisors of the May be loaned to said county of Jackson, is hereby authorized and empowered to loan to the said county of Jackson, for the

term of five years, all such drainage fund income, now in the hands of the county treasurer of the said county
