point some suitable person to fill such office, who, after being duly qualified, shall hold his office until the next annual election for city officers, and until his successor shall be elected and qualified.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 144.

[Published March 29, 1862.]

AN ACT to provide for the relief of the town of New Richmond, in St. Croix county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Excess of tax in 1858, to be credited on tax of 1862.

SECTION 1. The county board of supervisors of St. Croix county, are hereby authorized to ascertain what amount of taxes, in consequence of alleged eror [error] in equalization and assessment, was levied upon the real and personal estate in the town of New Richmond, in said county, in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight, more than said town ought equitably to have paid for that year; and the amount so ascertained shall be credited by said supervisors to said town of New Richmond, and applied upon the taxes to be levied and collected in said town for the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
