CHAPTER 381.

[Published June 24, 1862.]

AN ACT for the relief the Monroe county agricultural society.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

Order on treasurer.

SECTION 1. The secretary of state is hereby authorized and directed to issue an order upon the state treasurer, in favor of the Monroe county agricultural and manufacturing society, pursuant to section five of chapter 53 of the general laws of 1858, in the same manner as though the annual report of said society had been received on the first day of February, 1862: *provided*, said report be on file in the office of the secretary of state at the time of the passage of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 382.

[Published June 24, 1862.]

AN ACT to authorize the secretary of state to audit certain accounts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

For engraving state bonds.

SECTION 1. The secretary of state is hereby authorized to audit the account of the American bank note

company for engraving and printing Wisconsin state bonds; said account to be duly verified by affidavit, and its correctness certified to by the governor, secretary of state and state treasurer, under whose direction the bonds were engraved.

SECTION 2. A sum of money sufficient to pay the account referred to in section one of this act, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated. Appropriation.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 383.

[Published June 24, 1862.]

AN ACT to change the time of holding the annual meeting of school district No. 1, in the town of Palmyra.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The annual meeting of school district number one, of the town of Palmyra, in the county of Jefferson, shall hereafter be held on the first Monday of August, in each year. The hour of its meeting shall be half past seven o'clock in the afternoon, unless otherwise provided by a vote of the district, and duly recorded at its last annual meeting. First Monday of August.

SECTION 2. The provisions of section 9 of chapter 23 of the revised statutes, shall not apply to the aforesaid school district.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
