AN ACT for the relief of the several towns, cities and villages of the county of Fond du Lac.

CHAPTER 9.

[*Published February 8, 1862.*]

AN ACT to amend chapter 276 of the general laws of 1861, entitled "an act to amend chapt. [chapter] 22 of the general laws of 1859, entitled 'an act relative to the sale of lands for unpaid taxes, and the conveyance and redemption thereof.'"

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 276 of the general Legality of sales advertised in pa-

per in Douglass
county.

laws of 1861, is hereby amended, by inserting after the word "notice," in the twelfth line of said section, the following: "*provided*, the foregoing enactment shall not affect the legality of any publications for the sale of unredeemed lands that may be advertised in any newspaper published in Douglas [Douglass] county."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Presented to the governor, January 30, 1862, and not returned to the senate with objections.

CHAPTER 10.

[Published February 7, 1862.]

AN ACT to extend the time for the collection of taxes in the county of Shawanaw.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Extended to
March 3.

SECTION 1. The time for the collection of taxes, except state taxes, in the county of Shawanaw, is hereby extended to the first Monday of March next.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 11.

[Published February 8, 1862.]

AN ACT to amend section 31 of chapter 134 of the revised statutes, entitled "of executions and proceedings supplementary thereto."
