

CHAPTER 246.

[Published April 22, 1863.]

AN ACT to appropriate the sum of six thousand dollars for the purchase of stationary [stationery] for the use of the state officers and the next legislature.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The sum of six thousand dollars is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the purchase of stationary [stationery] for the use of the state officers and the legislature, for the ensuing year. The said sum of six thousand dollars may be drawn from the treasury by the superintendent of public property, after he shall have given bonds, as required by chapter twenty-seven, section seven, of the revised statutes.

CHAPTER 247.

[Published April 22, 1863.]

AN ACT to repeal sections sixteen and seventeen of chapter nine of the revised statutes, and chapter thirty-six of the general laws of 1858, entitled "of the legislature."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections sixteen and seventeen of chapter nine of the revised statutes, and chapter thirty-six of the general laws of 1858, are hereby repealed.
