

CHAPTER 254.

[Published April 23, 1863.]

AN ACT to amend chapter 170 of the general laws of 1861, entitled "an act to appropriate certain islands in the Wisconsin river, in the county of Wood, to the Grand Rapids bridge company."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

Appropriation of islands.

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and seventy of the general laws of the year 1861, is hereby amended, so as to read as follows: "That the several islands in the Wisconsin river, situate, lying and being in the county of Wood, be and the same are hereby appropriated to Reuben C. Lyon, Samuel S. Bensley and James McGrath, as commissioners, in trust for the Grand Rapids bridge company: *provided*, said commissioners shall, within three years from the first day of April, A. D. 1861, cause the said islands to be measured and surveyed by some competent surveyor, and also, within the same time, cause a certificate, signed by said surveyor, to be filed in the office of the secretary of state, describing such islands, and showing the number of acres and parts of an acre therein contained."

Lands to be surveyed, &c.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 255.

[Published April 23, 1863.]

AN ACT to repeal chapter 345 of private and local laws of 1857, entitled "an act to incorporate the village of Black Earth."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

Repeal.

SECTION 1. Chapter 345 of private and local laws of 1857, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
