## CHAPTER 283.

[Published April 23, 1863.]

AN ACT to amend chapter 317 of the private and local [general] laws of 1860, entitled "an act to amend an act to incorporate the city of Sheboygan, and the several acts amendatory thereof."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section five of chapter three hundred ordinances, &c., and seventeen of the private and local [general] laws in English and of 1860, is hereby amended, so as to read as follows: German. "The common council, at their first annual meeting in each year, or as soon thereafter as may be, shall designate not more than two papers printed in said city of Sheboygan, one printed in the English language, and one printed in the German language, in which shall be published all ordinances and other proceedings and matters required by the act to which this act is amendatory, or by the by-laws or ordinances of the common council, to be published in a newspaper."

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 284.

[Published April 23, 1863.]

AN ACT to authorize the quartermaster-general of the state to effect a settlement with J. V. Robbins, upon a contract made by him with the state, upon the eighteenth day of November, A. D. 1861.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The quartermaster-general of this state Settlement beis hereby authorized and empowered to settle with J. J. V. Robbins. V. Robbins, upon his contract with this state, made and entered into upon the eighteenth day of November, A. D. 1861; and if upon such settlement any amount shall be found due to the said Robbins, upon the con-
