

1864, for which year said salary may be fixed and determined by said common council at any time before the charter election for said year.

SECTION 3. The salary thus fixed and determined upon, shall be paid out of the city treasury out of any moneys not otherwise appropriated, and may be paid at the end of every quarter. How salary to be paid.

SECTION 4. The fees now allowed by law to the treasurer of said city, shall be collected by him and paid into the city treasury for the use of said city. Fees to be paid into treasury.

SECTION 5. All acts and parts of acts conflicting with this act, are, for the purposes of said act only, hereby repealed. Repeal.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 178.

AN ACT to change the time of holding annual meetings in school district number five, in the town of Wauwatosa.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The annual meetings in school district number five, in the town of Wauwatosa, shall hereafter be held on the last Monday of August, in each year. The hour of such meeting shall be seven o'clock in the afternoon, unless otherwise ordered by a vote of the district, duly recorded, at the last annual meeting. To be held last Monday of Sept.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
