

CHAPTER 295.

[Published April 18, 1864.]

AN ACT relating to the jurisdiction of certain counties on the Saint Croix lake and river.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The counties of Pierce, Saint Croix, Polk and Burnett, and such other counties as shall hereafter be organized within this state, upon the Saint Croix river and lake, shall have jurisdiction, in common, in all offenses on said river, within the jurisdiction of the state, and such offenses may be heard and tried in either of said counties in which legal process against the offenders shall be first issued, in like manner and to the same effect as if the offense had been committed within the county in which such process shall be issued.

Persons guilty of offenses on St. Croix river, may be tried therefor in any county on said river.

SECTION 2. All civil processes from either of the counties named in the preceding section, and from such other counties as shall hereafter be organized upon the Saint Croix river or lake, may be executed upon that part of said river or lake which lies within the jurisdiction of this state.

CHAPTER 296.

[Published April 19, 1864.]

AN ACT to provide for the expenditure of the drainage fund in Shawano county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. That portion of the interest of the drainage fund due the county of Shawano, for the year 1864, shall be paid over to the county treasurer of said county, at the same time with the money due the said county from the school fund for the said year.
