

county of Manitowoc, on the 29th day of February, 1864, for the purpose of raising funds to pay bounties to volunteers, and all the official acts of the board of supervisors and treasurer of said town in connection therewith, and the action of said board of supervisors in extending the time for the collection of said tax to the second day of May, 1864, is and are hereby declared to be legal and valid, notwithstanding all requirements of the law may not have been complied with.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 367.

AN ACT to repeal section twenty-one of chapter three hundred and ninety-five of the general laws of 1862, relating to the time in which actions may be commenced against the city of Milwaukee.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

Repeal.

SECTION 1. Section twenty-one of chapter three hundred and ninety-five of the private and local [general] laws of 1862, entitled "an act to amend an act entitled 'an act to consolidate and amend the act to incorporate the city of Milwaukee, and the several acts amendatory thereof,'" is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
