

## CHAPTER 220.

[Published May 8, 1865.]

AN ACT to authorize the boards of supervisors of the counties of Manitowoc and Outagamie to give the clerks of the circuit court of their respective counties a salary.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The boards of supervisors of the counties of Manitowoc and Outagamie may give the clerks of the circuit court of said counties, respectively, a salary, in lieu of the fees now provided by law, to be paid out of the county treasury to the said clerks of the circuit court, for all services hereafter rendered by such clerks, and which are now made payable out of such treasury. Clerks of court may be made salaried officers.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 221.

[Published May 8, 1865.]

AN ACT to amend chapter 236 of the general laws of 1863, entitled "an act to amend chapter 193 of the private and local laws of 1859, entitled 'an act to incorporate the village of Oconto,'" and to legalize the assessment and collection of taxes in the village of Oconto, for the years (A. D.) 1863 and 1864.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 236 of the general laws of 1863, is hereby amended, by striking out the word "January," where it occurs in the twelfth line of said section, and inserting the word "February" in lieu thereof. Amendment.

SECTION 2. The assessment and collection of taxes in and for the village of Oconto, for the years (A. D.) 1863 and 1864, and the sales of lands and lots for the Legalized.
