

CHAPTER 86.

[Published February 17, 1865.]

- AN ACT to legalize the disbursement of all bounty funds to volunteers for the town of Clinton, in the county of Rock, during the year 1864.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Bounty tax proceedings legalized.

SECTION 1. All the proceedings of the supervisors and other agents of the town of Clinton, county of Rock, in disbursing the bounty funds of said town to volunteers, during the year 1864, are hereby legalized and declared valid and binding.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 87.

- AN ACT to repeal chapter 165 of the general laws of 1863, relative to the publication of the delinquent tax list in the county of Winnebago.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Repeal.

SECTION 1. Chapter 165 of the general laws of 1863, entitled "an act relative to the publication of the delinquent tax list in the county of Winnebago," is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
