

CHAPTER 102.

[Published April 15, 1867.]

AN ACT to authorize the secretary of state to purchase Wisconsin reports, to complete exchanges with other states.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The secretary of state shall be authorized to purchase a sufficient number of such volumes of the Wisconsin reports as are not owned by the state, to enable him to furnish complete sets of reports to such of the United States as have or shall hereafter furnish full sets of reports for the library of the state of Wisconsin. Sec'y of state may purchase Wisconsin reports.

SECTION 2. An amount sufficient to pay for the reports purchased under the provisions of this act, is hereby appropriated from any money in the state treasury belonging to the general fund, not otherwise appropriated, to be paid by the state treasurer upon the warrant of the secretary of state. Appropriation

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 103.

AN ACT to repeal chapter 349 of the general laws of 1860, entitled "an act to amend chapter 184 of the revised statutes, entitled 'of inquests of the dead.'"

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Chapter 349 of the general laws of 1860, entitled "an act to amend chapter 184 of the revised statutes, entitled 'of inquests of the dead,'" is hereby repealed. Repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
