JOINT RESOLUTION authorizing secretary of state to procure index to revised statutes and general laws, and to provide for their distribution.

*Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring,* That the secretary of state cause to be made a digest or complete index of all the amendments to the revised statutes and general laws of the state, and cause a sufficient number of copies of the same to be printed in pamphlet form, to be distributed to the state, county and town officers, and that he cause the same to be distributed in the same manner as the session laws.

## NUMBER 12.

PREAMBLE AND RESOLUTIONS in relation to submitting an amendment of the general banking law of this state to a vote of the people.

WHEREAS, An act entitled "an act to amend the general banking law of this state," approved April 12, 1866, and published as chapter 143, general laws of 1866, contains no provision for submitting the same to a vote of the people: therefore,

*Resolved by the senate and assembly of the state of Wisconsin,* That it shall be and hereby is made the duty of the secretary of state to submit said act to the voters of this state at the general election to be held in November, 1867, for their approval or rejection.

*Resolved,* That the votes for the approval of said act shall be "for amendment to the banking law," and the votes against the approval shall be "against the amendment to the banking law;" and the votes thus given shall be counted and returned by the inspectors of elections and be canvassed by the state board of canvassers in the same manner as votes for state officers are counted, returned and canvassed.

*Resolved,* That it shall be the duty of the secretary of state to publish these resolutions in the state paper at least thirty days before said general election, and also to publish in said paper the result of the official canvass of the vote upon said amendment.
