JOINT RESOLUTION providing for the completion of the transcribing of reports of committee on claims.

Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the joint committee on claims is hereby authorized to employ Aaron V. Fryer to complete the first volume of the reports of the committee on claims, and appropriations made thereon, by transcribing therein the reports and appropriations of the territorial legislature at the session held in the year (*A. D.*) 1847, and in like manner to complete the second volume of reports, being the reports and appropriations of the state legislature for the years 1853, 1854 and 1855, which will bring the same up to the year (*A. D.*) 1856, when the third volume was commenced, and has since been regularly kept up. All expenses to complete the first volume of the reports shall not exceed twenty-five dollars, nor for the whole work hereby authorized to be done, including the said first volume, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, and shall also be in full satisfaction for all work heretofore done by said Aaron V. Fryer on the volumes hereinbefore referred to.

JOINT RESOLUTION directing secretary of state to have section 40 and the provisions of section 41 of the act of congress, approved June 3d, 1864, [published.]

Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the secretary of state is hereby directed to have published for four weeks in at least one newspaper in each place in which national banks are located in this state, for the information of assessors and collectors of taxes, section 40 and the provisions in section 41 of the act of congress approved June 3d, 1864, entitled "an act to provide a national currency," &c.
