

## CHAPTER 90.

[Published March 8, 1869.]

AN ACT to repeal chapter 175, general laws of 1865, pertaining to the St. Croix and Lake Superior railroad company.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Chapter one hundred and seventy-five of the general laws of 1865, entitled "an act to confer upon the St. Croix and Lake Superior railroad all the rights and privileges granted and conferred to the state of Wisconsin by the acts of congress approved June 3, 1856, and May 5, 1864," is hereby repealed. Repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 91.

[Published March 9, 1869.]

AN ACT to amend chapter 258, general laws of 1864, so as to authorize the county of Pierce to vote for aid for right of way to any railroad company which may locate a line of railroad therein.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter 258, general laws of 1864, is hereby amended as follows: after the word, "railroad" in the fifth line by adding thereto, "or on any line of railroad which may be located through the county of Pierce by any railroad company." Section 1 amended.

SECTION 2. Section two of said act is hereby amended after the word, "counties" in the fourth line by inserting, "and of Pierce county." Section 2 amended.

SECTION 3. Section three of said chapter 258 is hereby amended by inserting after the word, "counties" in the third line, "and of Pierce county."

SECTION 4. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 92.

[Published March 9, 1869.]

AN ACT to amend section two, chapter 150, general laws of 1867, entitled "an act to regulate the fees and prescribe the duties of clerks of the circuit court."

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Amended.

SECTION 1. Section two of chapter 150 of the general laws of 1867, entitled "an act to regulate the fees and prescribe the duties of clerks of the circuit court," is hereby amended by adding to the end thereof the following: "for filing mechanics' liens, ten cents; for docketing the same, for each defendant, twenty-five cents: *provided*, that said fees shall not exceed one dollar in any one case.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
