laws of 1859, and the list mentioned in section sixteen of the same chapter, shall be so divided in the county of Rock, as to authorize said statement and notice and said list, so far as relates to lands lying and being situate within the fourth assembly district in said county, comprising the towns of Turtle, Beloit, Newark and the city of Beloit, to be published in a newspaper printed within such assembly district, the effect thereof being the same in all respects as if no such division had been made, and the said statement and notice and the said list mentioned in said sections had been published in one newspaper, as provided by said chapter twenty-two.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 95.

AN ACT to amend chapter 26 of the general laws of 1868, entitled "an act to authorize the appointment of phonographic reporters for the circuit courts of the counties of Racine and Rock."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amended.

SECTION 1. Section two of chapter twenty-six of the general laws of 1868, is hereby amended by striking out the word, "seven" where it occurs in said section and inserting in lieu thereof the word, "ten."

SECTION 2. All other acts or parts of acts conflicting with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
