

CHAPTER 63.

[Published March 19, 1870.]

AN ACT to amend section 1 of chapter 64 of the general laws of 1859, entitled "an act to amend chapter 134, of the general laws of 1858, entitled 'an act concerning testimony.'"

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter 64 of the general laws of 1859, entitled "an act to amend chapter 134 of the general laws of 1858, entitled 'an act concerning testimony,'" is hereby amended so as to read as follows: In all actions wherein any corporation shall be a party, the adverse party may be examined as a witness in his or her own behalf, upon the trial of the same, without notice, as in other actions. Amended.

SECTION 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 64.

AN ACT to repeal chapter sixty-two of the general laws of 1869, entitled "an act to increase the number of county supervisors in the county of Green, and to provide for their election."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter sixty-two of the general laws of 1869, entitled "an act to increase the number of county supervisors in the county of Green, and to provide for their election," is hereby repealed. Repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
