

CHAPTER 70.

[Published March 19, 1870.]

AN ACT to amend chapter 117 of the revised statutes, entitled "of county courts."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 117 of the revised statutes, Amended, entitled "of county courts," is hereby amended by adding thereto a section to be known as section 66, which shall read as follows: "Section 66. An appeal may be taken to the supreme court from all orders of allowance or disallowance of appeals provided for in this chapter."

SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts contravening the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 71.

AN ACT to exempt certain persons from service as jurors.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. One dispensing druggist in each prescription drug store in this state shall be exempt from serving as a juror in any and all courts of this state. Exempt from serving as juror.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
