AN ACE to amend chapter fourteen (14) of the revised statutes, entitled "of resignations, vacancies and removals, and of the supplying of vacancies"

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Sub-division four (4) of section one (1) Amended. of chapter fourteen (14) of the revised statutes is hereby so amended as to read as follows: "4. By sheriffs to the governor, and by all officers who hold their special elections office by election, except officers elected at town meetings, to the officer or officers respectively authorized by law to order a special election to fill such offices respectively."

SECTION 2. Sub-division six (6) of section two (2) Amended. of said chapter is hereby so amended as to read as follows: "6. The neglect or refusal of any person reelected to such office to renew his official bond on such neglect to re-re-election, or to deposit the same in the proper office new bond.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
