

CHAPTER 126.

[Published April 1, 1871.]

AN ACT to amend chapter fourteen (14) of the revised statutes, entitled "of resignations, vacancies and removals, and of the supplying of vacancies"

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Sub-division four (4) of section one (1) of chapter fourteen (14) of the revised statutes is hereby so amended as to read as follows: "4. By sheriffs to the governor, and by all officers who hold their office by election, except officers elected at town meetings, to the officer or officers respectively authorized by law to order a special election to fill such offices respectively."

Certificates of special elections.

SECTION 2. Sub-division six (6) of section two (2) of said chapter is hereby so amended as to read as follows: "6. The neglect or refusal of any person re-elected to such office to renew his official bond on such re-election, or to deposit the same in the proper office within the time prescribed by law."

Amended.

Penalty for neglect to re-new bond.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

AN ACT to fix the time of holding the terms of the circuit court in the 4th judicial circuit.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
