

CHAPTER 204.

[Published March 29, 1873.]

AN ACT in relation to the swamp lands in the town of Burke,
Dane county, Wisconsin.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate
and assembly, do enact as follows:*

How drainage
fund may be
expended.

SECTION 1. The provisions of section twenty-one of chapter five hundred and thirty-seven of the general laws of 1865, for the purposes of this act, are suspended, so far as the same relates to the swamp lands in town of Burke, Dane county, Wisconsin, and the supervisors of said town are hereby authorized to expend the drainage fund now in the treasury of said town, or which may hereafter be received, for the purpose of reclaiming any swamp lands in said town, whether the same are within the definition of the term, "swamp lands," as used in said section twenty-one or not.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 205.

AN ACT relating to statistics of property exempt from taxation.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate
and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Assessors to
report statistics
of exempt prop-
erty.

SECTION 1. It is hereby made the duty of all assessors throughout the state, when making out the next assessment roll, as now provided by law, to enter in books or on blanks, to be procured and furnished to them as hereinafter stated, in regular order, in the name of the owner, if known, from the best information they can obtain, a correct and pertinent description of all real and personal property, excepting such as is now exempted from taxation by subdivisions six, eight, nine, ten, eleven and twelve of section two of chapter one hundred and thirty of the general laws of 1863, in
