

CHAPTER 106.

[Published March 4, 1875.]

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and eighty-two, laws of 1860, entitled, "An act providing for an increase of highway-tax in the county of Richland."

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one, of chapter one hundred and eighty-two (182), of the laws of 1860, is hereby amended by striking out the word "county," where it occurs, and insert in lieu thereof the word counties, and by inserting after the word "Richland," the words "and Shawano," so that it shall read as follows: The electors of the several towns in the counties of Richland and Shawano may, at the annual town meetings, held in their respective towns, order that an additional tax, not exceeding ten mills on the dollar valuation, to be raised for the improvements of highways and bridges therein, and such tax so ordered, shall be assessed, collected and disbursed in the same manner as other highway taxes in said towns.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 107.

[Published March 6, 1875.]

AN ACT to amend section one (1), of chapter two hundred and twenty (220), of the general laws of 1874, amendatory of section ten (10), of chapter one hundred and sixty-seven (167), of the general laws of 1864, entitled, "an act regulating the fees of the lumber-inspector of lumber-district number two."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The lumber-inspector of lumber-district number two, shall be entitled to receive, and may sue for and collect, the sum of three and one-half cents
