

## CHAPTER 16.

[Published February 20, 1875.]

AN ACT in relation to towns and town officers.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

Unlawful to hold certain offices at the same time.

SECTION 1. That hereafter it shall be unlawful for any person to hold the office of Town Treasurer and Town Assessor at the same time, within this State.

SECTION 2. That all acts and parts of acts conflicting with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 17.

[Published February 20, 1875]

AN ACT to repeal chapter two hundred and seventy-one (271) general laws of 1874, entitled "An act to fix and regulate costs in county courts in probate business."

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

Chap. 271, G. L. 1874, repealed.

SECTION 1. Chapter two hundred and seventy-one (271) of the general laws of 1874, an act entitled "An act to fix and regulate costs in county courts in probate business," is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
