

the notice thereof shall specify the hour of the day at which such vote shall be taken; *and provided further*, that the electors of any town or incorporated city or village, or any school district which contains within its limits an incorporated village, may, at the time appointed to take such vote, *viva voce*, order and determine that such vote shall be taken by ballot, and when such order shall be thus made, the vote shall be by ballot. The vote upon the question of establishing high schools in towns, incorporated villages, cities, and school districts which contains within its limits an incorporated village, shall be canvassed and determined in the same manner as now provided by law for canvassing and determining votes upon other questions relating to such municipalities, and special meetings for consideration of this matter shall be called and held in the same manner as now provided by law for calling and holding special meetings for other purposes.

SECTION 3 [2]. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 133.

[Published March 15, 1876.]

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and nine (109), of the general laws of 1874, entitled, "An act to provide for the proper safe-keeping of the report of the geological survey."

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section two (2), of chapter one hundred and nine, of the general laws of 1874, is hereby amended by adding at the end of said section, the following: *And provided further*, that the chief geologist may withdraw said report for exhibition to the legislature or its committees, and for the purpose of using said report in the preparation of the final report required by the law establishing the survey. Amended. Geological report.

SECTION 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.
