SECTION 3. Section thirty-two of said chapter two hundred and forty-three, is hereby amended by inserting after the word, "reports," where it occurs in the eighth line of said section, the words "excepting that of the secretary of state, of which there shall be printed three thousand copies, and excepting that of the superintendent of public instruction, of which there shall be printed eight thousand copies." Amended.
Number of reports to be printed.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 339.

[Published April 1, 1876.]

AN ACT to repeal chapter three hundred and forty-eight (348), of the laws of Wisconsin of 1874, entitled, "An act to amend chapter forty-six (46), of the general laws of 1869, entitled, 'an act to protect the lands and timber granted to the St. Croix and Lake Superior Railroad Company.'"

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter three hundred and forty-eight (348), of the laws of Wisconsin of 1874, entitled, "An act to amend chapter forty-six (46), of the general laws of 1869, entitled, 'an act to protect the lands and timber granted to the St. Croix and Lake Superior Railroad Company,'" is hereby repealed. Repealed.
And section three (3), of chapter forty-six (46), of the general laws of 1869, entitled, "An act to protect the lands and timber thereon, granted to the St. Croix and Lake Superior Railroad Company," is hereby revived, re-enacted and declared to be in full force, virtue and effect as it was before the passage of said chapter three hundred and forty-eight (348), of the laws of Wisconsin, of 1874. Re-enacted.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
