

CHAPTER 59.

[Published February 29, 1876.]

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money therein named for the use of the state prison, for the payment of current expenses for the year ending March 1, 1877.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, the sum of twenty-seven thousand eight hundred and seventy dollars, in full for the payment of current expenses at the state prison, for the year ending March 1, 1877. Appropriation.

SECTION 2. All sums of money appropriated by this act shall be drawn from the state treasury not oftener than monthly in advance. To be drawn monthly.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 60.

AN ACT to appropriate to Fred. A. Dennett and R. M. Strong each the sum of fifty dollars.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the general fund to Fred. A. Dennett the sum of fifty dollars for services in opening the present session of the senate, and to R. M. Strong the sum of fifty dollars for services in opening the present session of the assembly. Appropriation.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
