CHAPTER 49.

AN ACT to authorize the city of Janesville to issue bonds, to provide and pay for engine houses in said city.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The common council of the city of Janesville is hereby authorized and empowered by a vote of a majority of all the members of said council, to borrow money and issue city bonds therefor, with interest coupons attached in the usual form, signed by the mayor and countersigned by the clerk of said city of Janesville, to provide and pay for engine houses in said city. Said bonds shall be denominated "engine house bonds," not exceeding one thousand dollars each, nor in the aggregate exceeding the sum of ten thousand dollars, and bearing interest not exceeding eight per cent. per annum, and payable annually, the principal payable within ten years from the date of said bonds, at such time and place as said council shall direct; and the faith of said city is hereby pledged for the payment of said bonds, principal and interest, and the proceeds of the issue of said bonds shall be deposited with the treasurer of said city, to be drawn and disbursed by said common council for the purposes and in the manner herein indicated.

Authority to issue bonds.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
