CHAPTER 181.

AN ACT to repeal section two of chapter one hundred and sixty-nine of the general laws of 1871, entitled, "an act to amend chapter one hundred and fifty-five of the general laws of 1863, entitled 'an act to codify the laws of this state relating to common schools.'"

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section two of chapter one hundred and sixty-nine of the general laws of 1871, entitled "an act to amend chapter one hundred and fifty-five of the general laws of 1863, entitled 'an act to codify the laws of this state relating to common schools,'" is hereby repealed. Repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 182.

AN ACT to repeal chapter two hundred and forty-four of the laws of Wisconsin for 1874, entitled an act to declare a certain highway in Door and Kewaunee counties a state road, and all acts amendatory thereof.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter two hundred and forty-four of the laws of Wisconsin for 1874, and all acts amendatory thereof, are hereby repealed. Repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
