CHAPTER 230.

AN ACT to fix the time for holding the general and special terms of the circuit court in the eighth judicial circuit.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The general terms of the circuit court in the eighth judicial circuit shall hereafter be held in each year as follows: In the county of Buffalo, on the second Monday in May and first Monday in December. In the county of Dunn, on the second Monday of March and the second Monday of September. In the county of Eau Claire, on the fourth Monday in March and the fourth Monday in September. In the county of Pepin, on the third Monday in April and third Monday in October. In the county of Pierce on the second Monday in June and the second Monday in December. In the county of St. Croix, on the third Monday in May and the third Monday in November.

General terms fixed.

SECTION 2. All the general terms held in the county of Eau Claire shall be special terms for the whole circuit.
