CHAPTER 323.

AN ACT to authorize the Red Wing and Trenton Transit Company to transact business in the state of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The Red Wing and Trenton Transit Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of Minnesota, is hereby authorized to transact business in this state pursuant to the articles of association: *provided*, that the said corporation shall, before acting under the license hereby given, file with the secretary of state of this state a certified copy of its said articles of association. Authorized to transact business.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 324.

AN ACT to provide for a state park in the state of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. All lands belonging to the state of Wisconsin, lying in townships forty (40), forty-one (41), forty-two (42), forty-three (43), and forty-four (44) north, of ranges four (4), five (5), six (6), seven (7), and eight (8) east of the fourth principal meridian, in the state of Wisconsin, are hereby dedicated and set apart for a state park, and no such lands not now sold or contracted to be sold shall hereafter be sold, nor shall any privilege, license or authority be given to any person or persons whomsoever, to cut down or destroy any timber growing on such lands. Lands set apart.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
